Nancy M. Rodenbaugh, age 81, of Lewes, Delaware, passed away on Saturday, March 28, 2015, at her home. She was born on May 12, 1933, in Yorklyn, Delaware, daughter of the late Howard Allen and Martha Agnes (Peirson) Magargal.

Mrs. Rodenbaugh enjoyed a 16-year career as a Senior Secretary at the DuPont Company in the Legal Department, finishing her career in the Patent Division.
