Roseen B. Haenn, age 65, of Milton, DE passed away on Thursday, February 26, 2015, at the Delaware Hospice Center, in Milford, DE. She was born Wednesday, August 31, 1949 in Londonderry, Northern Ireland, daughter of the late Michael and Margaret (Doherty) Kealey.

Mrs. Haenn enjoyed a lifelong career as an Accounting Technician for the US Army at Fort Knox, KY and then for AT&T Government Solutions, where she retired in 2007. She was devoted to her Cancer Support Group at the Tunnell Cancer Center in Rehoboth Beach. 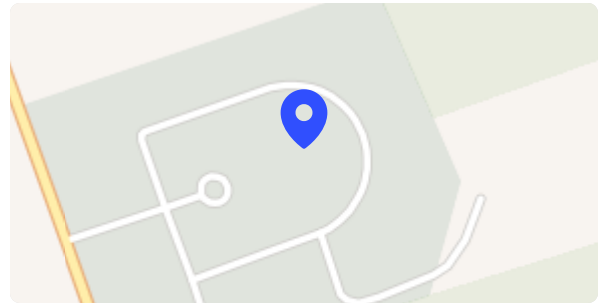
