**M**arian Catherine Hocker Marshall, age 92, of Lewes, DE passed away on Wednesday, January 14, 2015 in her home. She was born on June 29, 1922 in Union City, NJ, daughter of the late Elwood W. and Frances (Malinerick) Hocker.

Mrs. Marshall graduated from Lewes High School in 1944 and began her career as a Secretary at Ft. Miles, DE. She married T. Rowland Marshall on July 25, 1945. Marian participated in many organizations including the Junior League of Wilmington, Junior Board of the Memorial Hospital, the Lewes Yacht Club and DAR. She was a long time member of St. Peters Episcopal Church. Mrs. Marshall enjoyed playing bridge, reading mystery books, shelling in Sanibel, FL and had a special interest in pelicans.
