**D**aniel J. Vrencur, age 71, of Lewes, DE passed away on Friday, November 14, 2014 at his home.

Daniel attended the University of St. Thomas in St. Paul, MN and then received a Doctorate Degree in Chemistry from Purdue University in 1970.
