Eunice Iona Baker, age 92, of Ocean City, MD passed away on Monday, August 4, 2014 at Atlantic General Hospital in Berlin, MD. She was born in Cambridge, MD on October 29, 1921, daughter of the late Wilbert S. and Nellie J. (Bramble) Dean.

During her early years Mrs. Baker was very active helping her children with the Girl Scouts, Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts.
