Daniel Agostarola, age 92, of Lewes, DE, passed away on Saturday, May 17, 2014 at his home. He was born on May 3, 1922 in Philadelphia, PA, son of the late Alfredo and Mary (Capanich) Agostarola.

Mr. Agostarola received the Camden County Military Service Medal for his honorable service in the United States Army Air Corps during World War II. He was a dedicated 20 year member of the American Legion Post 28 and a former parishioner of the Catholic Church of St. Mary in Cherry Hill, NJ.

Mr. Agostarola enjoyed playing poker games with his family and friends alike. He was an avid reader who enthusiastically read six newspapers every day. He was also a master at crossword puzzles and an avid fisherman. Mr. Agostarola was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, ggpop and a dear friend who will be missed dearly.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Agostarola was preceded in death by his wife, Millie Agostarola (Messina) in November of 1990 and his son, Robert Agostarola in July of 1993. He is survived by his two daughters: Joanne Agostarola and Denise Balsama; two grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.
