Joseph R. Gordon, age 82, of Rehoboth Beach, DE passed away on Friday, May 9, 2014, at Delaware Hospice Center, Milford, DE. He was born on November 19, 1931 in Providence, RI, son of the late Joseph Raymond and Helen (MacGillivray) Gordon.

Mr. Gordon proudly served in the United States Army for 20 years, achieving the rank of Master Sergeant. Following his retirement from active duty, Mr. Gordon was honorably discharged in 1969.
