Louis Eric Griffith, 65, of Rehoboth Beach, passed away suddenly on Monday, May 9, 2016, at Beebe Healthcare in Lewes. He was born on May 3, 1951, in Washington, D.C. son of the late Louis R. Griffith and survived by his mother Mary Griffith and sister Stephanie Glasgow and fiancé Nicholas Kong. Eric is survived by his wife of 39 years, Sheila (Anderson) Griffith, his son, Justin Eric, and daughter, Jennifer (Griffith) Taylor and her husband Thor Taylor.
