Louise Martha (Schmidt) Morris passed away in Lewes, DE on Monday January 9, 2017. Louise was born in Madison, NE on August 9, 1931, youngest daughter of the late Herman Schmidt and Louise Rhode Schmidt.

Louise graduated from high school in Fremont, Nebraska where she later attended Midland Lutheran College. In the early 1950's Louise moved to Washington D.C. and worked at the National Bureau of Standard Laboratory, and later at the Dental Research Laboratory of the National Institute of Health.

Her hobby was the care and feeding of birds and animals and while living in Washington was noted for attracting and feeding mocking birds and other birds at her open fourth floor dining room window sill along a busy avenue. Such care and feeding continued in later years in Rehoboth Beach, Delaware in the trees and shrubs at her home.

She is survived by her loving husband of sixty years, Hayden Morris as well as two sisters, Ruth Schmidt and Ada Jones and was predeceased by one sister Beata Schmidt and three brothers, Alfred, Herman and Louis Schmidt.

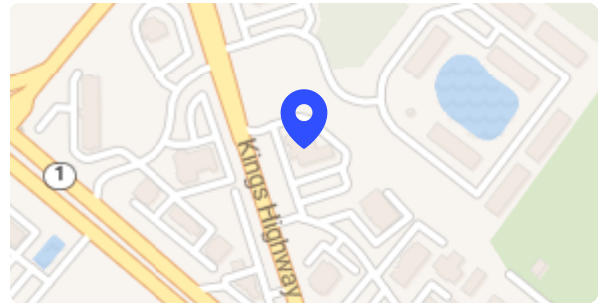
