Mr. Gunning worked in the Federal Court in Wilmington for many years. He was a retired court transcriber. 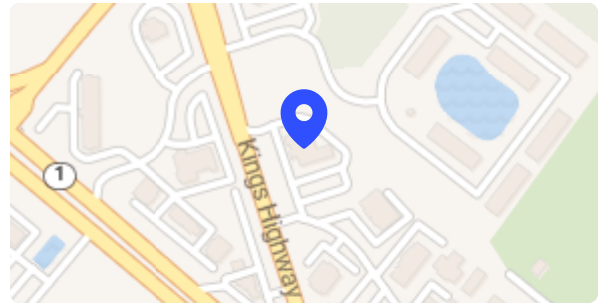

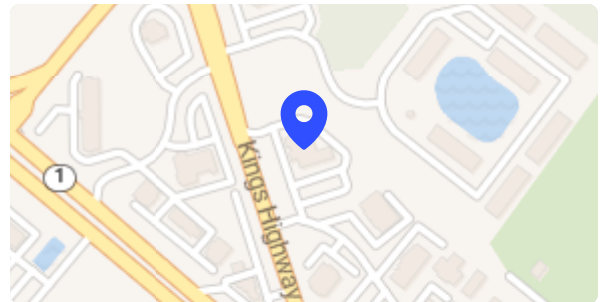
