**G**ustav A. Burnweit, Jr, 87, died at his home in Lewes, Delaware on March 12, 2017. He was born in Nyack, NY on October 4, 1929 to Emilie and Gustav Burnweit. He grew up, raised his family, and resided in Rockland County, New York, until relocating to Delaware in 1997.

Gus was an avid hiker and NY Giants fan, an active member of the Rotary Club and proprietor of Burnweit Pontiac, a business founded by his father. In recent years, he spent hours volunteering for Meals on Wheels and, during winters in Arizona, as a transporter at the local hospital.

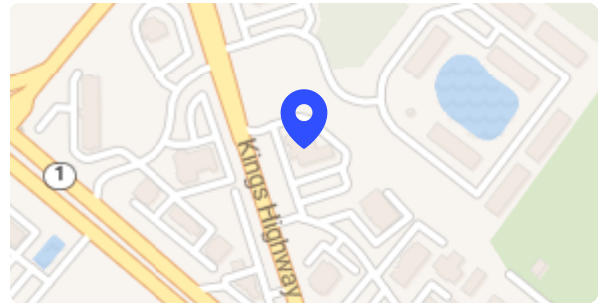

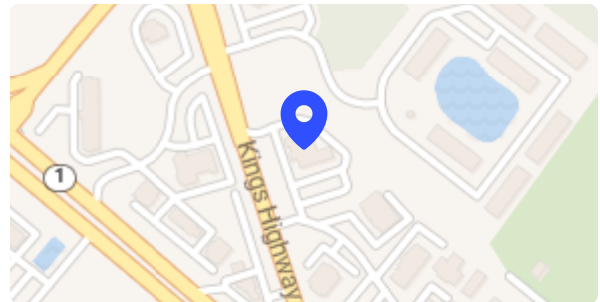

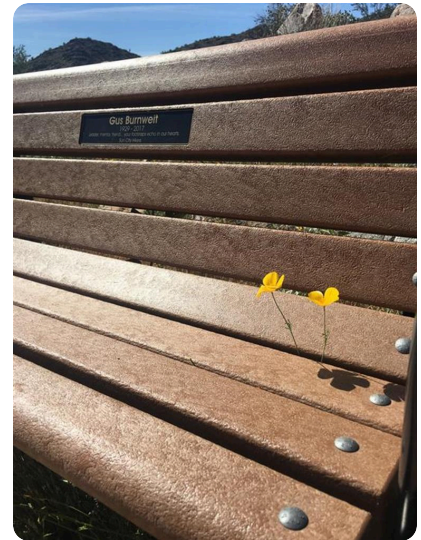
