## Frederick James Downs

SEP 28, 1959 - MAY 4, 2017

**F**rederick James Downs, age 57 of Lewes, DE passed away unexpectedly on Thursday, May 4, 2017. He was born September 28, 1959 in Philadelphia, PA, son of the late Frederick James and Nancy Pinto Downs.

Fred was a Villanova University graduate and worked at Handy and Harman Company in Camden, DE as a Human Resources Director. He was a member of the Wandendale Hunt Club, Ducks Unlimited, and the Elks Lodge 2540. Fred was a leader and very active in Troop 2540 Boy Scouts of America for many years and mentored countless youths during this time. He enjoyed hunting, boating, and spending time with family and friends.

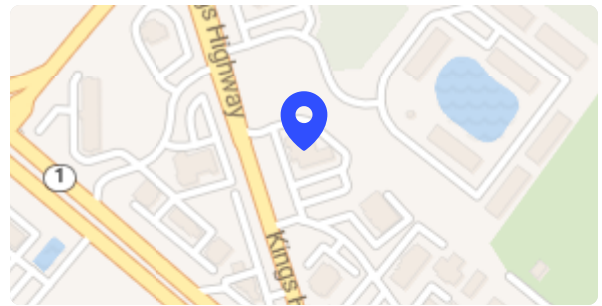
