Letty L. Stokaylo, age 92, of Lewes, DE passed away on Wednesday, May 31, 2017, at the Delaware Hospice Center in Milford, DE. She was born on Monday, March 30, 1925 in Kulpmont, PA, daughter of the late Russel Goretsky and Helen (Weslotsky) Goretsky.

Mrs. Stokaylo grew up in Kulpmont and following her high school graduation, she went to work for the US Pentagon in Washington, D.C. She soon met her first husband Marshall Wilson and settled in New Castle, DE where she would raise her family. 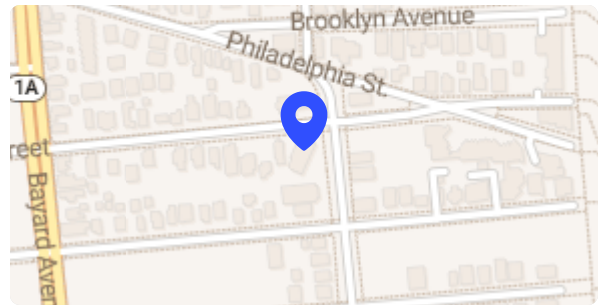

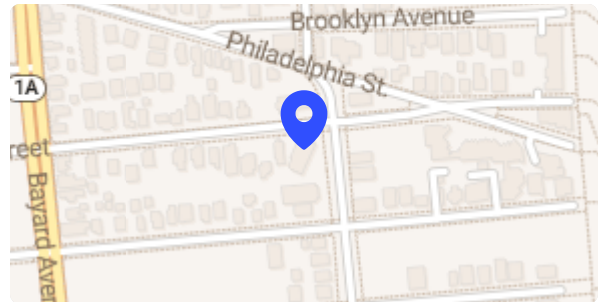

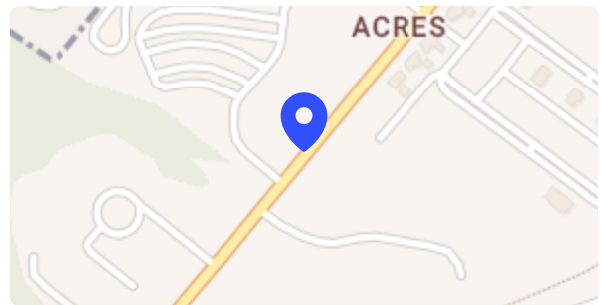
