Captain J. William Hocker, III, age 88 of Lewes, DE passed away on Friday, July 21, 2017, at Cadbury at Lewes. He was born Sunday, October 14, 1928, in Lewes, DE, son of the late John W. Hocker, Jr. and Theodosia (Marshall) Hocker.

Captain Hocker was a graduate of Lewes High School, Class of 1946 and was a proud member of the National Honor Society. Following school, he proudly served in the US Army during World War II and the Korean War. Mr. Hocker pursued a lifelong career with the Delaware Pilots Association as a River Boat Pilot retiring after 40 plus years. He was a former member of the Board of Directors for the Pilots Association. He also was a member of the Lewes Yacht Club and part of the Racing Committee, enjoying countless Sunday Sailfish Races. In his free time, Mr. Hocker enjoyed golfing, lobstering, crabbing, fishing and anything on the water. More than anything, he enjoyed the time spent with his loving family.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Hocker was preceded in death by his wife, Charlotte, in 2008, his son, Timothy in 1996, and brother, Thomas in 1990. He is survived by a sister, Margaret (Peggy) H. Lingo, his daughter, Diane H. Roth of Lewes, DE; his two sons: John William Hocker, IV and Cheryl of Rehoboth Beach, DE and Mark A. 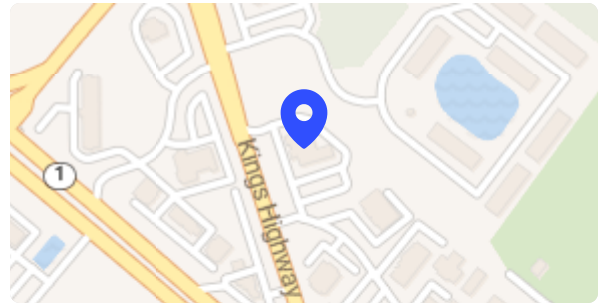

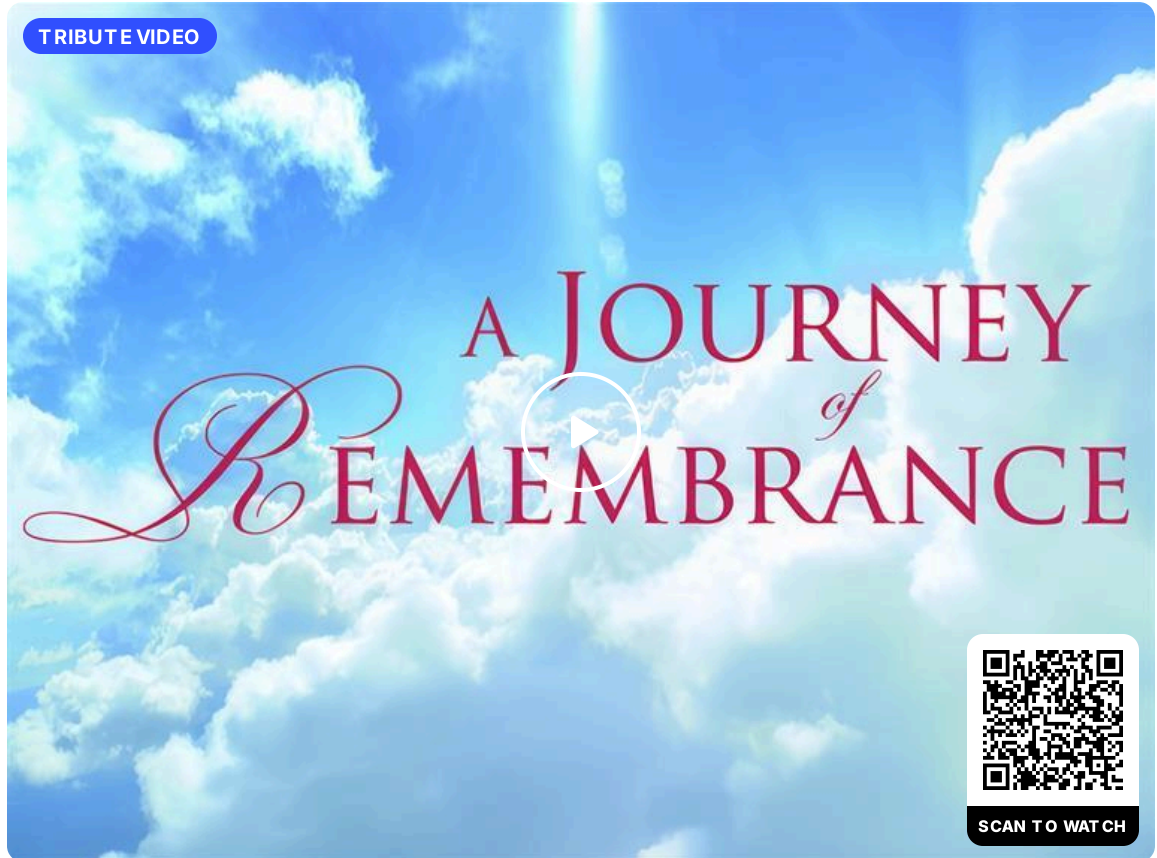
