**P**asqual Benjamin DeCarlo Sr., age 78 of Seaford, DE, passed away on Thursday, August 31, 2017 at Nanticoke Memorial Hospital. He was born in Coatesville, PA, on Sunday, July 16, 1939, son of the late Samuel and Mildred DeCarlo.

Mr. DeCarlo retired from Gulf Stream Aerospace Management in 2004 after a lifelong career. In his retirement he owned "Seats by Pat" and designed and completed custom motorcycle seats for Rommel Harley-Davidson of Seaford. He also did consignment work for "The Sewing Outlet" in Federalsburg, MD. Mr. DeCarlo was a member of the Knights of Columbus, was VP of Knights on Bikes, and a member of the Delmarva Harley Owners Group #3406. He loved motorcycling, hunting, fishing, boating, shooting firearms, golfing, and bowling. In the 1970s Mr. DeCarlo enjoyed managing several Fairborn Little League baseball teams and PeeWee football teams. More than anything, however, Mr. DeCarlo treasured the time he spent with his cherished family. He was a loving and devoted husband, father, grandfather, great-grandfather, brother, uncle, and friend. He will be deeply missed by all who knew and loved him.

In addition to his parents, Mr. DeCarlo was preceded in death by his beloved wife, Dorothy (Adkins) DeCarlo; his son, Pasqual B. DeCarlo, Jr; his son-in-law, Nolan Wilcutts; his brother, Leonard DeCarlo; and his sister, Eleanor Stevens. 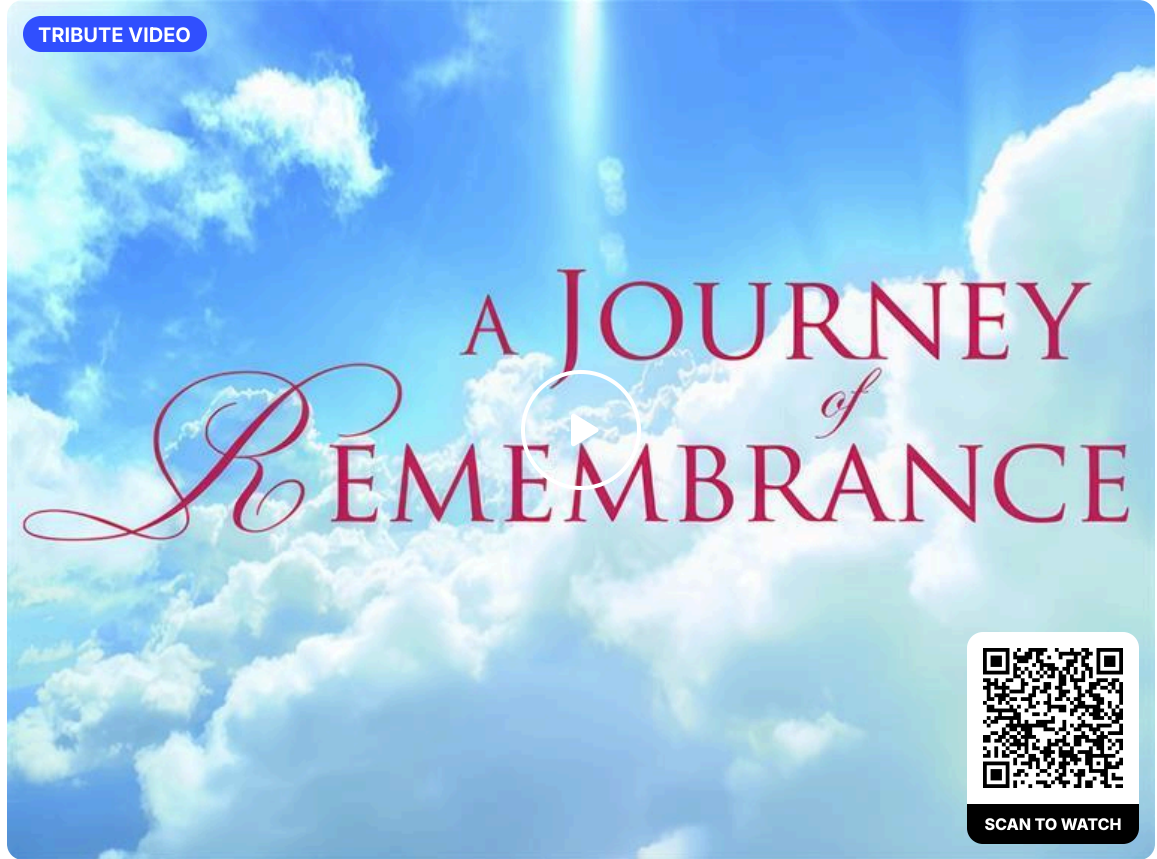
