Francis E. Kline , age 86, of Dagsboro, DE, passed away on Sunday, September 3, 2017, at Beebe Healthcare. He was born in North East, MD, on, June 8, 1931, son of the late Delbert Kline and Frances (Meekins) Kline.

Mr. Kline retired in 1986 from the US Government, having worked for 32 years at the Aberdeen Proving Ground as a Management Analyst. He was a US Air Force veteran having served during the Korean War. Mr. Kline was a member of the Community Lutheran Church in Frankford, DE and also was a 32 degree Past Master of the Masonic Lodge # 48 in Elkton, MD.

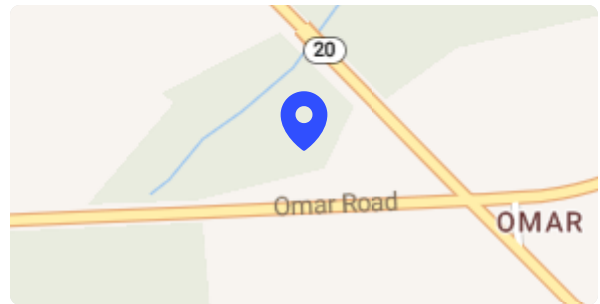
