Lillian "Lill" Hoopman, 74, of Charleston, entered into glorious rest with her Savior on September 2, 2017. Lill was born in Santa Ana, CA to the late John E. "Jack" and Lillian M. Burris. She graduated from Milford High School, DE and enjoyed Girl Scouts, American Legion Auxiliary Girls State, and varsity field hockey and basketball. Upon graduating from the University of Delaware with a BA in Education, she taught 12th grade history at Perry Hall High School in Maryland. Following her teaching career, Lill enjoyed caring for her family in Kingsville, MD. For a decade, she helped organize local designer show houses to benefit the American Cancer Fund. Lill served on the Board of Directors of Burris Logistics for 38 years. Alongside her parents, brothers, and Burris Logistics employees, Lill enjoyed volunteering for 30 years at the Milford Hospital Fair. Lill treasured her many family beach memories as a lifetime summer resident of Lewes, Delaware and in retirement on Kiawah Island, SC. 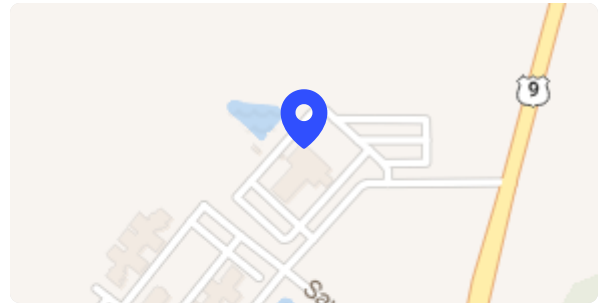
