Joseph M. Tridente, age 89 of Millsboro, DE, passed away on Monday, November 27, 2017, at Beebe Healthcare, in Lewes, DE. He was born October 1, 1928 in Molfetta, Italy, son of the late Dominic and Maria (Daiani) Tridente.

Mr. Tridente graduated from Eddystone High School in Eddystone, PA, Class of 1945. He proudly served his country in the United States Army during World War II.
