John C. Huss Jr. age 72 of Rehoboth Beach, DE passed away on Sunday, February 18, 2018 at his home. He was born on February 13, 1946 in Johnstown, PA, son of the late John C Huss, Sr. and Elizabeth Kiraly Huss.

Jack graduated from Westmont Hilltop High School in Johnstown, PA, class of 1964. He proudly served his country in the United States Marine Corps from 1966 to 1968 during the Vietnam War. Jack made his career working for the Chrysler Corporation in Newark, DE as a quality control officer, from which he retired after 36 years in 2001. He loved traveling for golf trips and scuba diving, as he was a certified scuba diver. Jack was a member of the ELKS Club, Cape Henlopen #2540 in Lewes and the American Legion Post 17.

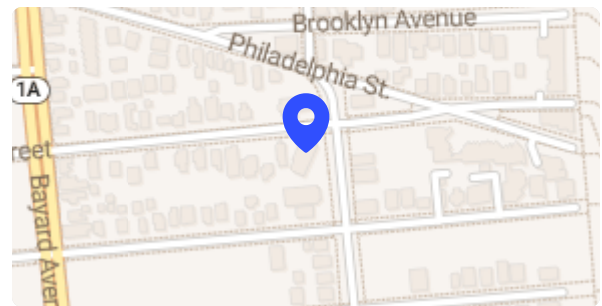

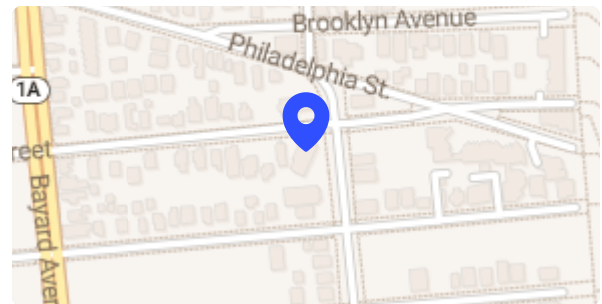
