Miroslav "Miles" Zich, 88 of Bridgeville, Delaware, formally of Rockville, Maryland, passed away March 21, 2018. He was born on February 14, 1930 in Chicago, Illinois, son of the late, Mona and Martin Zich.

Miles graduated from Illinois Institute of Technology in 1951. He was an electrical engineer, employed/retired from NAVALEX in Crystal City, Virginia. He also served in the Army during the Korean War in the Signal Corps Group. He was an avid sports fan, golfer, gardener, bridge player and enjoyed dancing (polka's especially!) and travel. 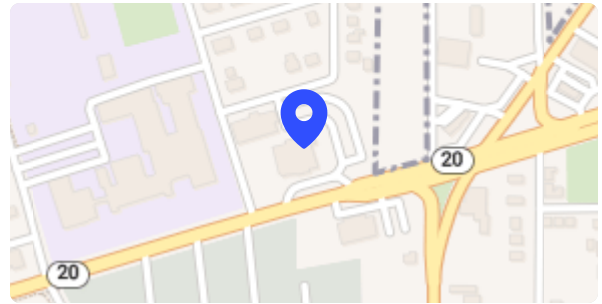

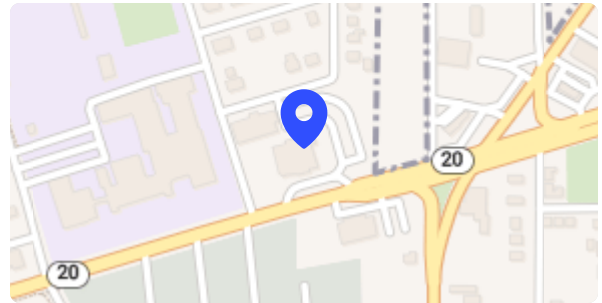
