# Cynthia King

APR 29, 1954 - MAR 22, 2018

**C**ynthia (Mascetta) King, age 63 of Lewes, DE, formerly of Cornwall and Yonkers, NY, passed away peacefully at her home surrounded by her family on Thursday, March 22, 2018. She was born on April 29, 1954 in Yonkers, NY, daughter of the late Anthony (Bill) and Nancy (Bonacci) Mascetta.

Cindy was a foreign language teacher for 28 years, first in the Pocantico Hills Central School District and then the Highland Falls Fort Montgomery Central School District in New York. She was a dedicated educator who cared deeply about her students, their education and the colleagues with whom she worked.

Cindy lived for her family. On October 10, 1976, she married Roger King, also from Yonkers, NY. Together they had two children, Elizabeth and Stephen. Cindy was the consummate homemaker, where she enjoyed cooking and sharing meals around the dinner table. An avid traveler, she enjoyed camping, cross-country trips and spending summers in Montauk, NY.
