Connor "Boh" Walter Bohan, age 77 of Dewey Beach, DE, passed away on Thursday, May 24, 2018, at Jefferson Hospital of Neuroscience in Philadelphia, PA. He was born Monday, November 25, 1940 in Washington, DC, son of the late Walter W. and Mary U. Bohan.

Mr. Bohan was a graduate of Gonzaga High School in Washington, DC and continued to Georgetown University where he graduated in 1962 with his Bachelors in Business. He worked a dedicated career for 51 years in the paper sales industry working for various companies, beginning with Whitaker Paper Company and ending with Cellmark. Mr. Bohan proudly served in the Army National Guard during the Cambridge Riots. He was a dedicated member of the Bowie and Dewey Beach Lions Club serving his communities for more than 43 years. In his free time, Mr. Bohan enjoyed gardening, watching the stock market and playing with the neighborhood cats. More than anything, he enjoyed the time spent with his loving family, especially when it involved a good celebration.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Bohan was preceded in death by his baby brother, Paul. 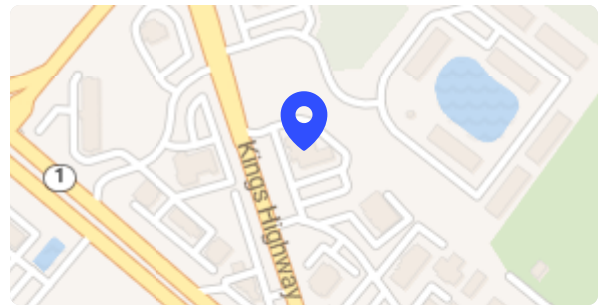

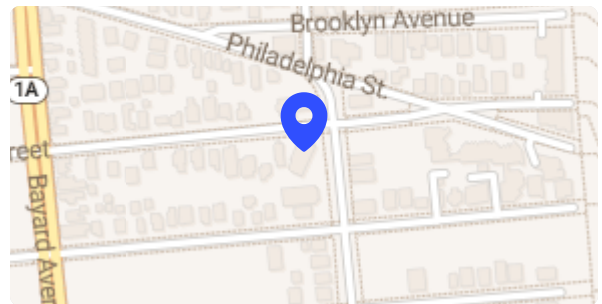

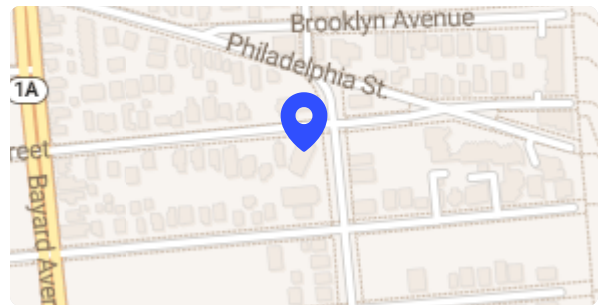
