Ronald Curtis Gutschall, age 39 of Lewes, DE, passed away on Friday, June 1, 2018, at St. Francis Hospital, in Wilmington, DE, as a result of a brain injury sustained 7 years ago. He was born Saturday, September 2, 1978 in Philadelphia, PA, son of Ronald F. and Veronica T. (Black) Gutschall.

Mr. Gutschall briefly served in the National Guard and worked as a salesman for various companies. He enjoyed music and dancing, and being a proud, born-and-raised Philadelphian, he was avid fan of the Phillies and Eagles. After leaving Philadelphia, he moved to New Jersey for a time, then most recently, to Delaware. Mr. Gutschall loved his family; none more than his beautiful daughters, for whom he lived. He was so loved by all who knew him, and he will be deeply missed.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Gutschall is survived by his daughters: Madison Leigh, age 12, and Anne Katharine, age 8, both at home; his brother, Bryan Gutschall (Stephanie Shaw) of Tabernacle, NJ; his nephew, Brayden Gutschall; and many aunts, uncles, and cousins.

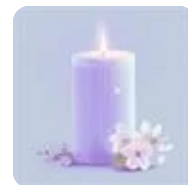
