# Christopher Bryan Wiggins

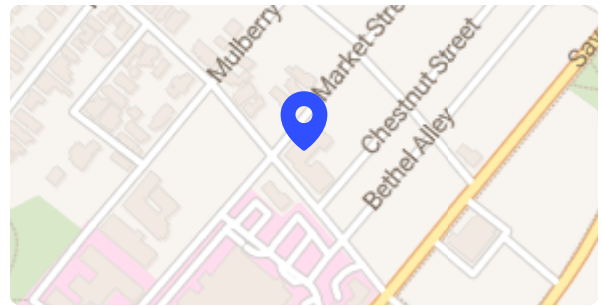

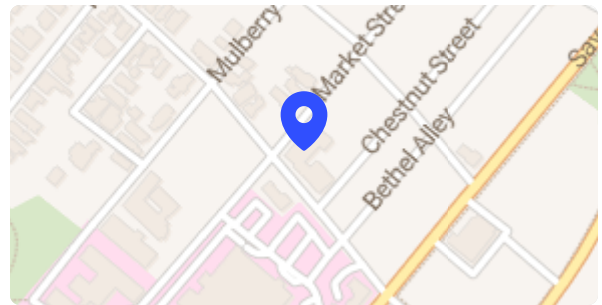
