Kenneth Elwood Brumbaugh, age 89 of Millsboro, DE, passed away peacefully at his home on Saturday, June 23, 2018, after a long illness. He was born on March 25, 1929 in Cincinnati, OH, son of the late Roy E. and Mildred M. (Turner) Brumbaugh.

Mr. Brumbaugh was a graduate of Lansdale High School, Lansdale, PA and Columbia Institute in Philadelphia, PA. He was a proud Veteran of the US Navy, serving honorably from 1946 to 1948. Mr. Brumbaugh was a self-employed public accountant in PA before retiring to Millsboro DE in 2003. On August 16, 1958, he married the love of his life, Diane Elaine Swartz in Telford, PA.
