Patricia Keenan Porta, age 78 of Lewes, DE, passed away on Tuesday, July 10, 2018, at her home after a short illness. She was born Sunday, March 17, 1940, in Cleveland, OH, daughter of the late James A. and Marjorie (Rooney) Keenan.

Mrs. Porta graduated from St. Francis School of Nursing in Pittsburgh, PA, in 1961 and earned her BSN from Rutgers University in 1978. She enjoyed a career as an occupational health nurse that spanned many years, with both AT&T Bell Laboratories and Lucent Technologies. On November 25, 1961, she married the love of her life, Robert Charles Porta, in North Canton, Ohio.

Mrs. Porta loved to travel. She was a skilled knitter, enjoying other needlework as well, an avid reader, and a fan of NPR. 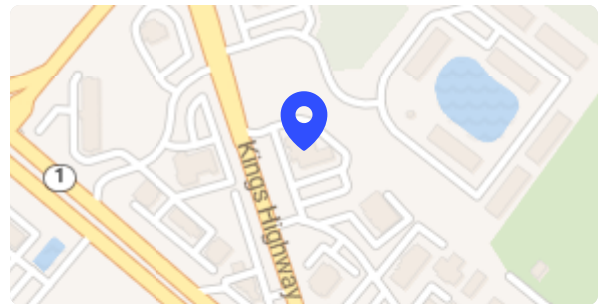

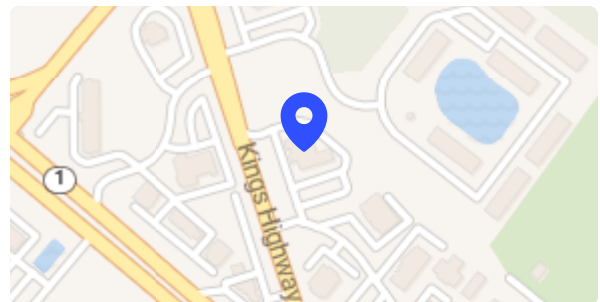

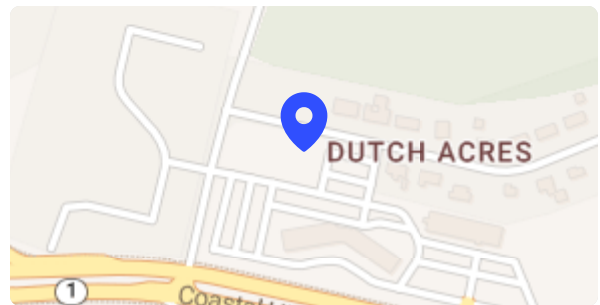
