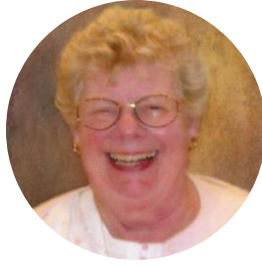

Mary "Peg" Margaret Tulloch, age 79 of Milton, DE, passed away on Tuesday, September 4, 2018 at Beebe Healthcare in Lewes, DE. She was born on Thursday, June 15, 1939 in Bristol, PA, daughter of the late William Joseph and Anne Rita O'Connor.

Mrs. Tulloch worked in various roles along her life, starting as an executive secretary for the WT Grant Company in New York City. She then worked as a teacher's assistant for Washington Township Public Schools in New Jersey and later in human resources at Rowan University. All during this time, Mrs. Tulloch raised a beautiful home and family.

Mrs. Tulloch was a parishioner of Saint Charles Borromeo Roman Catholic Church in Sicklerville, NJ where she was a member of the Sacred Heart Guild.
