George Edwin Christopher, Sr. age 90 of Rehoboth Beach, DE, formerly of Potomac, MD, passed away on Monday, October 1, 2018, at Beebe Healthcare, in Lewes, DE. He was born on October 28, 1927 in Baltimore MD, son of the late Alfred George Christopher and Annie Melvina (Wrightson) Christopher.

Mr. Christopher was devoted to his loving wife of 67 years, Evelyn .They met while attending the University of Maryland where he received his BS. He later went on to receive his Juris Doctorate Degree from George Washington Law School. Mr. Christopher served in the United States Navy during WWII.
