Calvin Timothy Rayne Jr., age 85, of Millsboro, DE, passed away peacefully on Friday, November 9, 2018 at, Beebe Healthcare. He was born in Selbyville, DE, on October 22, 1933 of the late Calvin Timothy Rayne, Sr. and Hazel (Long) Rayne.

Following his service to our country in the US Army, Mr. Rayne worked for Mumford Sheet Metal in Selbyville and as a painting contractor. He also worked full time as a custodian for the Indian River School District, at the Selbyville Middle School, and Phillip C. Showell Elementary, where he retired as Chief Custodian after 22 years of service. He was a founding member of the Roxanna Volunteer Fire Department. 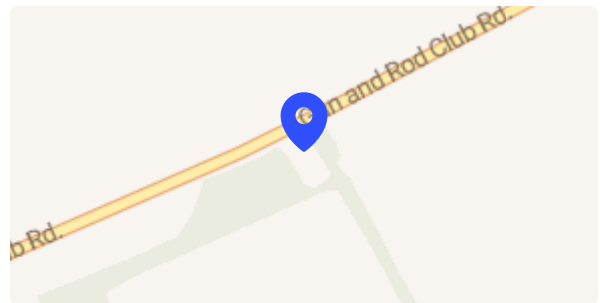
