# Horace "Hank" Campagnini

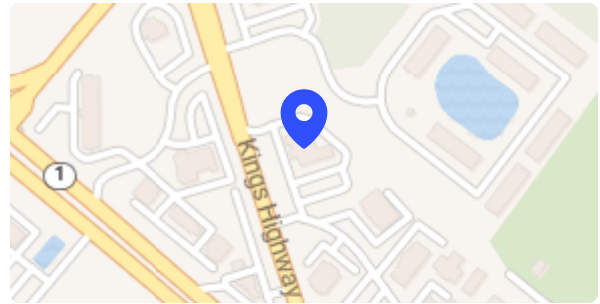

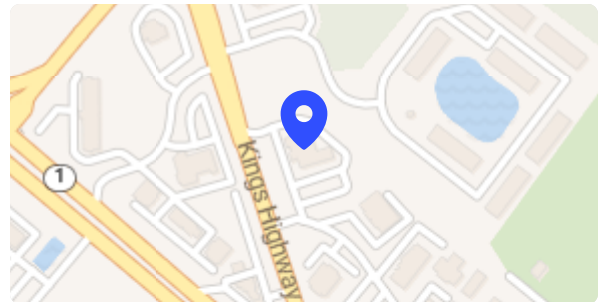
