**P**edro Pablo Fuertes, age 82 of Ocean View, DE, formerly of Silver Spring, MD, passed away on Tuesday, November 20, 2018, at Seasons Hospice, within Christiana Care Hospital due to complications from a stroke. He was born in Colombia, South America on October 6, 1936, son of the late Justo Fuertes Fonseca and Soledad Sierra de Fuertes.
