**M**ichael W. Moore of Milton, DE passed away suddenly at the age of 48 on December 7, 2018 from an aortic aneurysm at Beebe Healthcare in Lewes, DE.

Mr. Moore is survived by his parents, Kenneth G. Moore and Janet E. Moore of Lewes, DE; one sister, Gayle E. Rolak and her husband R.J. Rolak; two nephews, Ryan and Collin Rolak, all of Forked River, NJ; and his longtime companion and love of his life, Yvette Cruz of Milton, DE.
