Sidney Alfred Hart, age 91 of Ocean View, DE, passed away on Sunday, December 23, 2018 at Atlantic Shores Rehabilitation & Health Center in Millsboro, DE. He was born on July 31, 1927 in Philadelphia, PA, son of the late Joel and Lena (Goldblatt) Hart.

Mr. Hart was a proud US Navy Veteran, having served honorably in World War II. He built a career as a truck driver and retired from Spector Freight after 32 dedicated years. Mr. Hart was a life-member of VFW Mason-Dixon Post 7234 in Ocean View, DE as well as a member of American Legion Post 28 in Millsboro, DE. 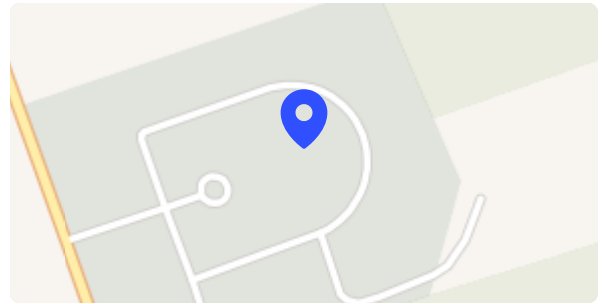
