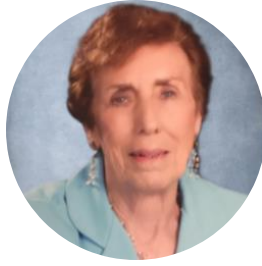

Guyla Lee Brinckmeyer, age 86 of Rehoboth Beach, DE passed away on Wednesday, January 23, 2019, at Beebe Healthcare, in Lewes. She was born on December 6, 1932 in Loyal, OK, daughter of the late Alfred and June Grabow.

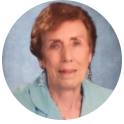
Mrs. Brinckmeyer was a 1951 graduate of Loyal High School, after which she attended Draughon's Business College in Oklahoma City. She married Jack, the love of her life, on March 14, 1952. Mrs. Brinckmeyer was the owner and operator of The Drift Inn Bed & Breakfast in Rehoboth Beach from 1977 until the time of her death.
