Thomas O. Jefferson, age 77 of Bridgeville, DE, passed away surrounded by his family on Saturday, February 2, 2019 at Nanticoke Memorial Hospital. He was born in Lewes, DE, on August 11, 1941, son of the late George and Margaret Jefferson.

Mr. Jefferson attended Bridgeville High School, after which he proudly served in the US Army. He was the owner and operator of Timmons Amusements, a family business that provides coin operated arcade games, prize cranes, pool tables, and jukeboxes to business establishments in the area. Mr. Jefferson was a member of the Loyal Order of Moose, Seaford American Legion, and Seaford VFW. He was a fan of NASCAR, as well being an avid fan and supporter of Woodbridge football and baseball. More than anything, Mr. Jefferson enjoyed time spent with his cherished family. He was a loving and devoted father, grandfather, great-grandfather, brother, uncle, and friend, who was loved by many and will be deeply missed by all who knew him.
