**J**ohn Victor Wiberg, age 86 of Rehoboth Beach, DE, passed away on Thursday, March 21, 2019, at his home. He was born on June 3, 1932 in Wilmington, DE, son of the late Harry E. and Eva Wiberg.

Mr. Wiberg was an ordained Baptist Minister for the majority of his adult life. He also worked in Human Resources for Potsdam State University in NY and Bristol College in Fall River, MA. Mr. Wiberg was a talented artist who specialized in oil and watercolor painting. In his retirement, he cultivated and honed his skills, becoming well known for his paintings of seascapes. Mr. Wiberg was a member of Bethel United Methodist Church in Lewes and was active in their choir. An avid surf-fisherman, he enjoyed time on the beach, casting a line at every opportunity. Above all, Mr. Wiberg cherished time spent with his beloved family and friends. He was loved by many and will be deeply missed by all who knew him.

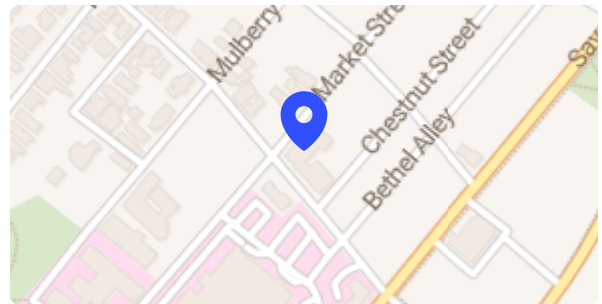

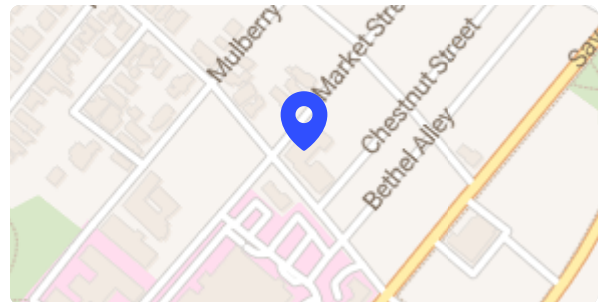

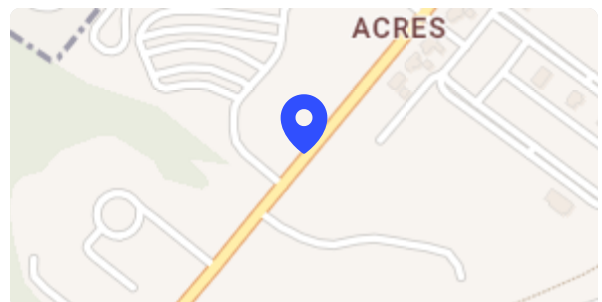
