# Oscar Eduardo Fernandini

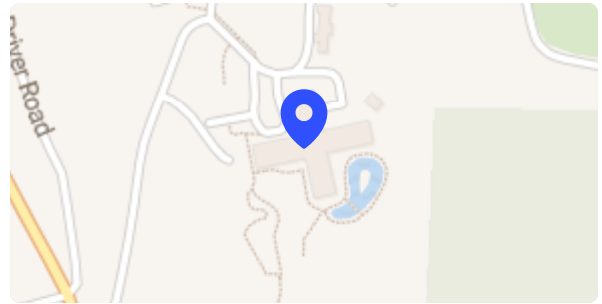

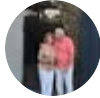
