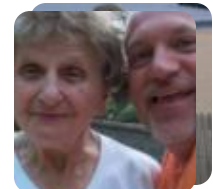
Dianne Duvall Vatalero posted:

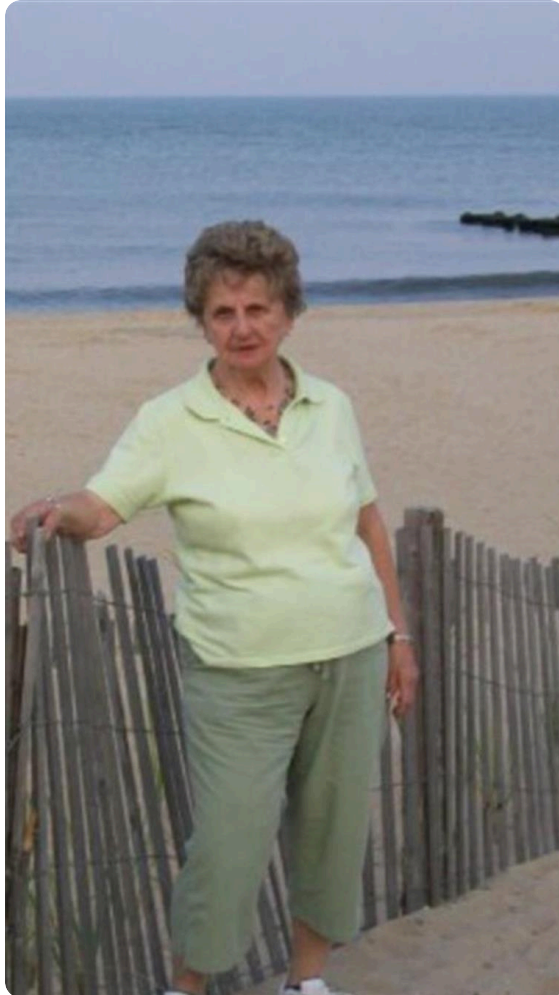

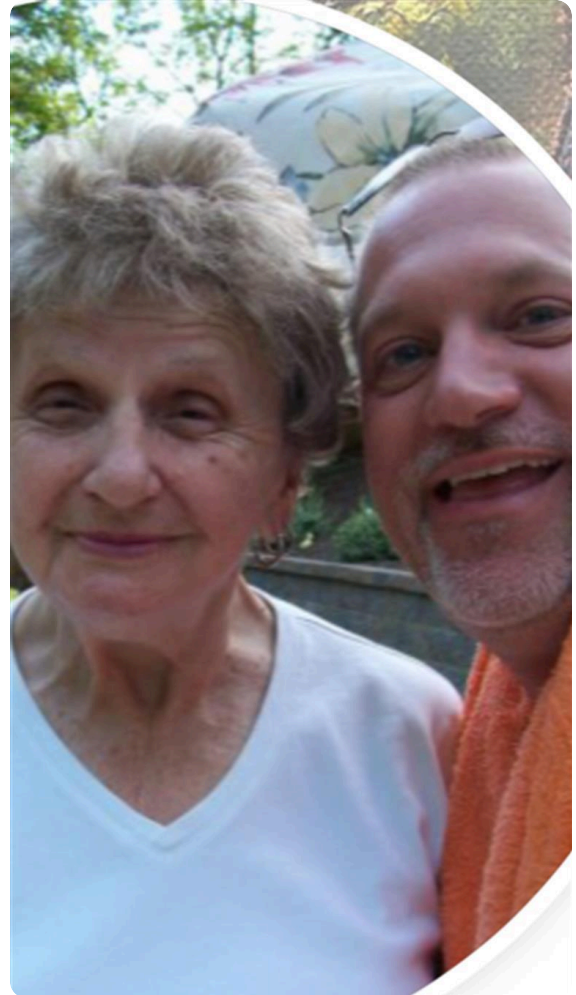
