Barry Lee Sellers, age 73, of Rehoboth Beach, DE, formerly of Lancaster, PA, passed away on Wednesday, August 21, 2019, at Beebe Healthcare, in Lewes, DE. He was born on August 5, 1946 in Ronks, PA, son of the late Walter and Mary Sellers.

Barry graduated from Conestoga Valley High School in Lancaster, PA, Class of 1964. He honorably served in the United States Army for four years. He then started his career in banking, working at Wachovia Bank, then later, working for Total Payroll Service in Lancaster, PA, from which he retired in 2012. It was then, he and his wife, Darlene, moved to Rehoboth Beach, DE. It was here, he enjoyed working part time at Outlet Liquors in the wine section. In his spare time, Barry loved baking, traveling and taking road trips, but most of all, spending time with his family.
