Donations may be made to Pike Creek Christian Preschool or Church in lieu of flowers.

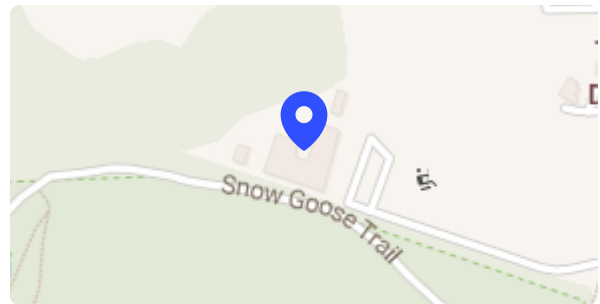

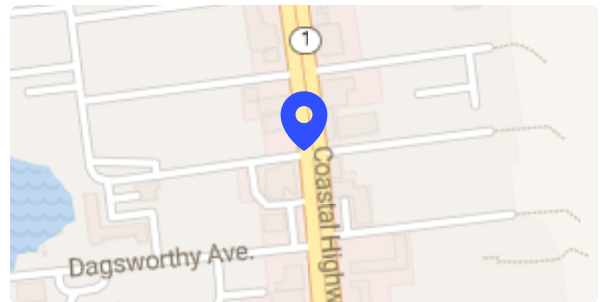

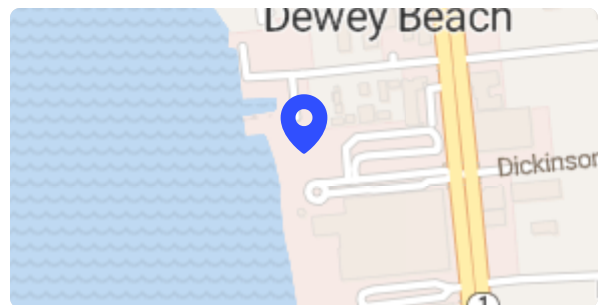
