Daniel William Peter Paul, age 68, of Ocean View, DE passed away on Monday, December 16, 2019, at Beebe Healthcare, in Lewes, DE. He was born on August 1, 1951 in Camden, NJ, son of the late William Daniel and Eleanor Jane (O'Connell) Paul.

Dan made his career as a printer salesman, retiring as Vice President of Sales on January 1, 2019 from Prism Color Corporation. He was a member of the Greater Wildwood Elks Lodge #1896. In his spare time, Dan enjoyed music, playing pool, golfing, going to the beach, and eating crabs. He was also a drummer in several bands over the years. He grew up in Haddon Heights, NJ and was an Eagles and Phillies fan.
