Richard "Rick" S. Pallack, age 74 of Lewes, DE, passed away on Thursday, January 30, 2020 with his loving wife by his side. He was born on July 1, 1945 in Suffern, NY, son of the late Vincent and Anna (Filak) Pallack.

Rick graduated from Ramsey High School in 1963 and proudly served in the U.S. Navy for two years. He then began his long career in the telecommunications industry.
