Dorothea F. Thomasson, age 94 of Lewes, DE, passed away on Thursday, May 7, 2020 at Harbor Healthcare & Rehabilitation Center, in Lewes. She was born on December 12, 1925 in Salisbury, NC, daughter of the late Paul and Mabel Fulenwider.

Mrs. Thomasson was a graduate of Lenoir-Rhyne University in Hickory, NC, Class of 1947. It was there she earned Bachelor's Degrees in chemistry and biology, thus beginning a career in molecular pathology at the National Institutes of Health in Bethesda, MD. Mrs. Thomasson adored the theater. She was a talented actress, involved in many Washington DC community theater productions in the 1960s and 1970s, as well as an avid writer and skilled artist.
