Neal Joseph Boyle, “Joe” loving husband, father, and friend, passed away on July 26, 2020 , at the age of 95. Born October 23, 1924 in Dorchester MA, he was the son of Neal Patrick and Beatrice Theresa Boyle.

Joe attended Boston College HS, Class of 1942, and graduated college from Georgetown University SFS in 1951. He served three years in WWII in the U.S. Coast Guard as an aerologist dispensing valuable weather data.

Joe retired from the American Red Cross as Vice President and CFO. He also had served as Sr. Vice President at GEICO. He was former Chairman of the Finance Commission of the International Federation of Red Cross, and Red Crescent Societies - Geneva, Switzerland. He is past President of the Washington, DC Chapter of the Financial Executives Institute. He was a former member of St. Jude’s the Apostle Finance Committee in Lewes, DE. where he was a member.

Joe was an avid collector of paper ephemera and specialized in his passion for vintage postcards. He was well known and respected within the community and was very well known by many within the antique collecting society.

In addition to his parents, Joe is predeceased by his first wife Tilda R. Boyle of 56 years, his brother Bill Boyle, and his sister Mary Steinmeyer. He is survived by his wife of 10 years, Jane A.
