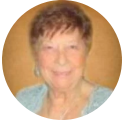

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and keeping with safety protocols, social distancing must be observed and masks are required at all times during all aspects of services.

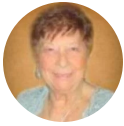

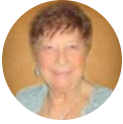


Heather & Jim Nardi lit a candle in honor of Lucy.
