**L**inda A. McClellan McMullan, age 71 of Rehoboth Beach, passed away peacefully, surrounded by angels on Thursday, December 17, 2020 at her home. She was born on December 18, 1948 in Chester, PA, daughter of the late William and Lillian Levenstein.

Linda grew up in Chester, PA and was a graduate of Chester High School. She moved to Aston, PA where she raised her family.
