**C**ynthia “Cindy” Lynn Queenin, age 65 of Bridgeville, DE and formerly of Bowie, MD, passed away on Tuesday, March 30, 2021 at TidalHealth Nanticoke Hospital. She was born on May 9, 1955 in Washington, DC, daughter of the late Robert E. and Anne T. Crowel.
