Sandra graduated from William Penn High School, and then continued her education at Goldey-Beacom College. 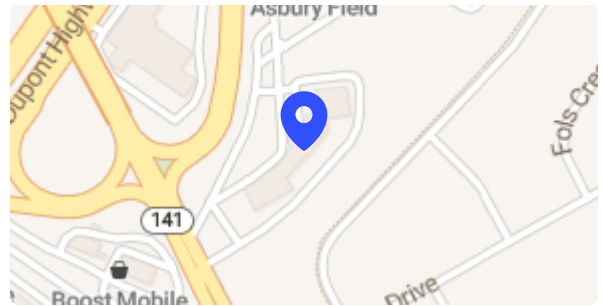

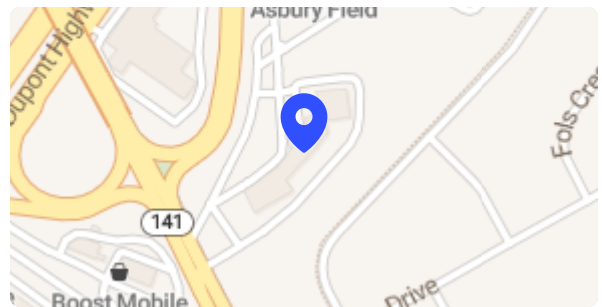

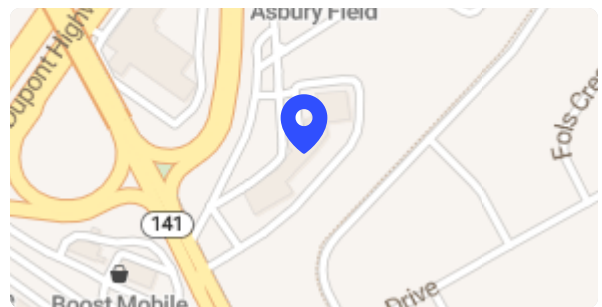
