Richard Sterling Insley, 76, of Rehoboth Beach, DE, passed away on July 15th, 2021.

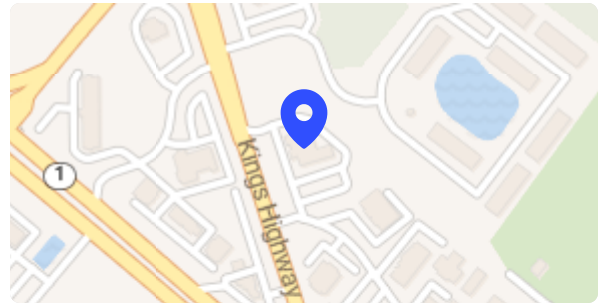

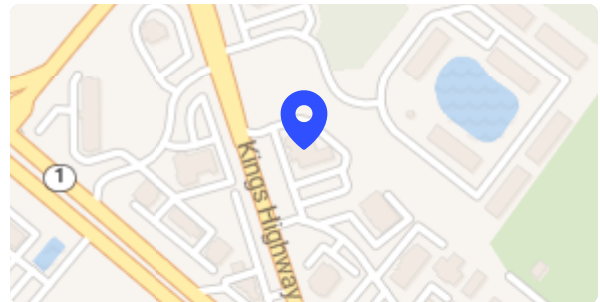

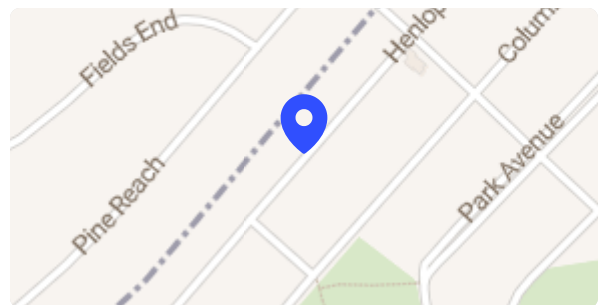
