Max Eugene Hoyt, age 88 of Lewes, DE, passed away at home on Sunday, August 1, 2021. He was born on June 9, 1933, in Fort Dodge, Iowa, son of the late Eugene and Irene (Small) Hoyt.

Mr. Hoyt was a proud veteran, having honorably served in the US Army with assignments in Fort Sam Houston in San Antonio, Texas, Vietnam, Alabama, Germany, Maryland, Washington, DC (Pentagon), and Walter Reed Hospital - formerly in Washington, DC. He retired as Colonel after 26 dedicated years.

Mr. Hoyt earned a master's degree in Hospital Administration. He married the love of his life, Margaret Hoyt in 1953. Mr. Hoyt was a loving and devoted husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather. He was loved by many and will be deeply missed by all who knew him.

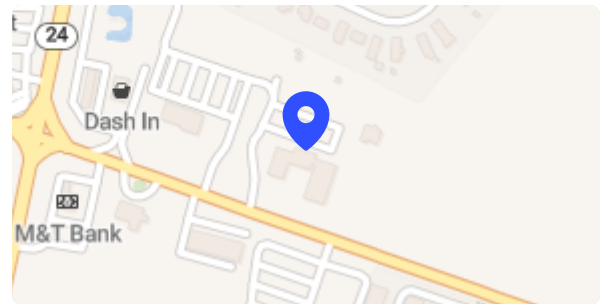

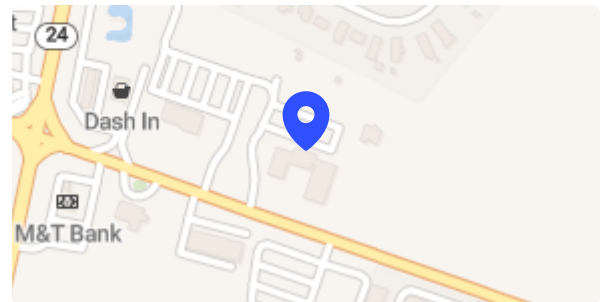
